Pennsylvania Life Member Stensland Elected President



Eaton Rapids, Mich. – Ronald Stensland of Lebanon, Pa. has been elected President of the VFW National Home for Children Board of Trustees. Stensland's election was confirmed during the Annual Meeting of Life Members on October 25.

Serving on the Board since 2004, Stensland has been part of the Public Relations Committee every year he has been on the Board, serving as chairman in 2007-2008. He also served on the Development Committee in 2004-2005 and 2005-2006, the Policy and Bylaws Committee 2007-2008 and the Executive Committee 2007-2008 and 2008-2009. Stensland has been a Life Member of the National Home since 2001 and in 2002, he became the Department of Pennsylvania National Home Chairman, a

position he held for two years.

Stensland is the Trustee for District 3 and represents the Departments of Delaware, District of Columbia, Pennsylvania, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

Stensland is a veteran of the Army and served in Korea from 1965-1966. He also served in Vietnam from April-October 1967 until he was wounded and medically retired in 1969. Stensland joined the VFW in 1970 and became a Life Member of VFW Post #23 in 1986 where he served as Post Commander from 1987-1989. Stensland is a Life Member of the Disabled American Veterans LebCo Chapter 81 and a Life Member of the Military Order of the Purple Heart Tri-County Chapter 1983.
