The VFW National Home for Children is governed by a Board of Trustees. Members of the VFW and Ladies Auxiliary who are Life Members of the National Home elect the trustees. There are 12 elected Trustees and five ex-officio members from the VFW and its Ladies Auxiliary National leadership. Trustees are elected for six-year terms and meet at least three times a year to conduct their responsibilities of oversight and policy setting. Duties of the trustees also include traveling, speaking and fundraising in support of the National Home.
