He served as the National Home’s Chairmen of the Development Committee, and has also sat on the Finance, Policy and Bylaws, Facilities and Public Relations/Communications Committees. Previously, Taylor served as Board President, elected in October of 2007, and Vice President in 2006.

The VFW National Home for Children is governed by a Board of Trustees elected from Veterans of Foreign Wars and Ladies Auxiliary members who are Life Members of the National Home. Trustees are elected for six-year terms and meet at least three times a year to conduct their responsibilities of oversight and policy setting. Duties of the Trustees include fundraising and promoting the National Home.
